

MUNICIPALITY OF CLANWILLIAM-ERICKSON

2024-2025 Road Gravelling Program

We are receiving quotes for Road Gravelling in the Municipality of Clanwilliam-Erickson. Qualified companies are invited to bid on the following:

1. Providing and spreading 9,000 – 13,000 cubic yards of crushed traffic gravel each year from 2024-2025 inclusive, on the municipal road network as directed by Council;

Please indicate a single price per cubic yard, which includes providing, loading, and spreading the crushed gravel, in your quote. Quotes may indicate a different price for each year (2024 and 2025) or a single price for both years.

2. At the Municipality's discretion, providing up to 3,000 cubic yards of crushed traffic gravel in a stockpile to be located at the municipal pit at SW 7-18-17 WPM, or another location as agreed upon by both parties. Please indicate the price for this item in each year separately from item 1.

Considerations

- a) Completion deadline is July 19 each year of the program. If work is not completed by the deadline, a lateness penalty of \$100 per day may be applied, or the Municipality may cancel the contract entirely.
- b) The municipal-owned gravel pit located at SW 7-18-17 WPM is available for mining new gravel, however any costs including those associated with removing overburden are the responsibility of the contractor.
- c) Traffic gravel must comply with the following specification:

Passing Standard Sieves	Crushed Traffic Gravel
19 mm Sieve	100%
12.5 mm Sieve	75 – 90%
4.75 mm Sieve (No. 4)	45 – 70%
425 um Sieve (No. 40)	10 – 35%
75 um Sieve (No. 200)	6 – 12%
Minimum Crush Count	35%
Maximum Shale Content	12%

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Municipal staff will regularly take samples of gravel supplied, and submit them to a third-party accredited lab for compliance testing. If the tested gravel does not comply with the municipal specification, the Municipality may require the contractor to stop work and take necessary steps to remedy the problem. If the contractor is not able to bring the supplied product into compliance, the Municipality reserves the right to renegotiate or cancel the contract.

- d) If using privately-owned pits to mine gravel, contractors may consider the private pits located at SE 7-18-17 WPM and N-1/2 33-18-18 WPM, or others located outside the Municipality, in determining cost per cubic yard. It is the contractor's responsibility to negotiate agreements and fees pertaining to gravel extraction with owners of private gravel pits.
- e) Municipal road maps with previous years' gravel application information are available on request.
- f) Amount of gravel to be applied on specific municipal roads will be at council's discretion after contract is awarded.

Quotes, clearly marked "GRAVEL PROGRAM", may be submitted in person during regular office hours and will also be accepted by email, fax, and/or post. Quotes must be received at the Clanwilliam-Erickson Municipal Office no later than 5:00 p.m. Central Standard Time, February 13, 2024.

Council reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotes or other offers as it may deem in its best interest.

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
