THE MUNICIPALITY OF CLANWILLIAM-ERICKSON BY-LAW NO.24/15

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CLANWILLIAM-ERICKSON TO CREATE THE POSITION OF DESIGNATED OFFICER FOR AN ASSISTANT CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

WHEREAS section 130 of the *Municipal Act* states as follows:

Establishment of Designated Officer Positions

130 A Council may by By-law establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a Designated Officer under a By-law of this or any other Act, and may give each such positions any title the Council considers appropriate.

AND WHEREAS Section 133 of *The Municipal Act* provides as follows:

133 Minutes must be made of each council meeting and signed by the person presiding at the meeting and a designated officer.

AND WHEREAS Section 134(1) of *The Municipal Act* provides as follows:

- **134(1)** Agreements and cheques and other negotiable instruments and agreements must be signed or authorized by
 - (a) the head of council or any other person authorized by the council; and
 - (b) a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the council for the Municipality of Clanwilliam-Erickson enacts as follows:

- 1. That the position of designated officer be created for the Municipality of Clanwilliam-Erickson.
- 2. That the Position of designated officer be given the title of "Assistant Chief Administrative Officer".
- 3. That the person appointed to the position of "Assistant Chief Administrative Officer" be delegated the following duties:
 - (a) Authority to sign minutes of council meeting
 - (b) Authority to sign agreements and cheques and other negotiable instruments and agreements on behalf of the municipality
