SUMMARY:

1.5 million return from insurance company. Chris Goertzen will not be running this year. Listed funding available thru grants for the upcoming year. Manitoba Infrastructure program has been approved, leg. Changes listed on AMM website. Consultations are happening thru July. Cannabis delayed 2-3 months. There is a economic development program being developed. MMSM contract has not been approved yet. Cosmetic pesticides no changes in 2018. MB Hydro increase 3.6% as of June 01, 2018. Asset management plans must be developed and implemented. Minister Wharton spoke talked about infrastructure funding, opening the municipal act to strengthen harassment legislation. There are a number of new councillor courses to be offered this summer across the province.

The focus was on the four winds initiative and the involvement of the provincial government. The main points are getting a letter of support from the province for the project. Getting recognition for our incorporation under the regional landfill authorities' act, and obtaining funding for us and Harrison Park to help in decommissioning the existing landfills. The main point being that the municipalities and the Federal government have stepped up to make the project work but the province has been absent. He promised to get back to us, but there is no timeline for when that will be.
